



SAFE USE OF CABLE & PIPE LOCATION EQUIPMENT TRAINING (CAT & GENNY)

A half-day training course aimed at all personnel involved in excavations where there is a likelihood of buried services.

The aim of the course is to train selected personnel in the skills and knowledge needed to achieve the standards of competence to carry out the duties of service location surveys before and during excavation.

Delegates are assessed by question and answer sessions during theoretical module. Then performance assessed during practical module. Course concludes with a question and answer assessment.

Module's covered include:

- Basic Service Location Theory
- Features and Functions of Cable Locators
- Features and Functions of Signal Generators
- Function Checking
- Practical Use of Locators, Generators and Accessories

Certificate of Competency issued to all delegates who successfully complete the course.

The Length of the course is approximately 3 hours.
